Stream Etiquette

- The trout stream is for fly fishing only. Fly fishing equipment is available to rent.
- All hooks must be barbless or have the barbs crimped before use.
- Please use rubberized nets for the landing of all trout.
- Please release all trout promptly. Grab a quick picture and gently send the trout on their way.
- Feeding trout is not permitted.
- Fishing the trout stream, Lower Legacy Lake, and Lake Canada is included as part of your tent or cabin rental. Guests staying in the RV Resort may fish the trout stream and Lower Legacy for \$50 per day per angler. Fishing Lake Canada is included in everyone's stay.
- Handle all trout with care:
 - Net all trout with a site-approved net and wet your hands before handling trout.
 - Make every attempt to keep trout in the water while removing the hook.
 - Please do not hold a trout by its gills or gill plate.
 - Please do not throw trout back into the stream; instead, place them back in the water, loosely holding by the tail until they are ready to swim off unassisted.
- Respect other anglers' space.
- Please no swimming, wading or climbing in the stream or on the structures.
- Please no throwing rocks into the trout stream.
- Pets are not allowed to wade in the trout stream.
- All trout must be released. Catch and keep is not permitted.

These rules are to respect the trout and protect our natural resources. Failure to adhere will result in losing fishing privileges and possible further action.
