














# STREAM ETIQUETTE

-  Fishing on the stream is reserved for fly fishing only. Fly rods are available in the gatehouse upon request.
-  All hooks must be barbless or have the barbs crimped.
-  All trout must be netted in a site approved net and released in a timely manner. Please check with the gatehouse staff on approved nets.
-  Feeding the trout is not permitted.
-  As a part of your clamping tent/cabin rental, fly fishing in front of your unit only is included in your stay. There is a \$75/angler upgrade fee to fish the banks of Lower Legacy Lake and the remainder of the trout stream. All overnight guests may fish Lake Canada at no extra charge.
-  Please handle all trout with care.
  - Net all fish with an approved net.
  - Wet your hands before handling trout.
  - Make every attempt to keep trout in the water while unhooking them.
  - Never hold a trout by its gills.
  - Never throw a trout back into the stream. Instead, place the trout back in the water and loosely hang onto it until it is ready to swim off without assistance.
-  Respect other anglers' space.
-  Please no swimming, wading or climbing in the stream or on the structure in the stream.
-  Please, no throwing rocks into the trout stream.
-  Pets are not allowed to wade in the trout stream.
-  All trout must be released. No catch and keep permitted.

These rules are put in place to respect the trout and to protect our natural resources. Failure to adhere will result in the loss of fishing privileges and possible further action.
